The 2019 A. Muse Blanc is basically a Malagousia, although there is 3% Gewürztraminer added in, unoaked, very dry (half a gram of residual sugar) and coming in at 12.8% alcohol. Elegant and sensually textured, this restores some of the grape's personality that was lost in the Chrisolithos White blend, but it is not exactly a high personality Malagousia. It doesn't substitute a lot of energy either. However, in texture and elegance, this understated Malagousia is a pleasure to drink at a very nice price. It should be perfect for drinking on its own now and through this coming summer. It is not entirely clear how long it will stay at peak, though; so for safety, I wouldn't hold it too long, no matter how long it theoretically lasts.
