The 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon was aged for 18 months in new French barriques and comes in at 13.6% alcohol. Tighter and more aggressive than the Merlots this issue, this has a bit of a hard edge, some oaky nuances and a big finish laced with good fruit and vanilla. I don't like it much more than the more elegant Merlots, but it certainly demonstrates some extra structure, which in turn may allow it to age a bit more gracefully. It might still develop more and improve. This, too, is a nice value, although oak-a-phobes may have some objection.
